- D01 Heavy Draft Weanling/Yearlings Mares
- D02 Heavy Draft Mares 2 and 3 Years
- D03 Heavy Draft Mares – Aged
Champion/ Reserve Champion Mare
- D04 Heavy Draft Geldings – All Ages
Champion/Reserve Champion Gelding
- D05 Heavy and Light Draft Youth Showmanship
- D06 Heavy Draft Weanling/ Yearling Stallions
- D07 Heavy Draft Stallions 2 -3 years
- D08 Heavy Draft Aged Stallions
Champion/ Reserve Champion Stallion
- D09 Heavy Draft Weanling/Yearling Haflingers
- D10 Light Draft type (under 15 hands & 1500#) Mares 2 yrs and older
- D11 Light Draft type (under 15 hands & 1500#) Geldings 2 Years and older
Champion/Reserve Champion Draft under 15 hands & 1500#

11:30 AM Performance (or immediately after halter if before 11:30 AM)

- D12 Heavy Draft Ladies Cart - Judged on driver's ability, appearance of hitch, animation & willingness.
- D13 Light Draft Cart - Judged on driver's ability, appearance of hitch, animation & willingness
- D14 Heavy Draft Men's Cart – Same Criteia as Ladies Cart
- D15 Heavy Draft Junior Cart Ages 8-18 – judged on driver's ability to work/show the horse in a cart – horse's age, animation, etc. not a factor; the driver alone is being judged.
- D16 Heavy Draft Show Tandem - On the rail
- D17 Single Cart Obstacle– timed event– penalties add time – show, parade or farm harness
- D18 Heavy Draft 6 Horse Show Hitch - On the rail
- D19 Farm Team – no fifth wheel wagons, no “show” harness
- D20 Heavy Draft 4 Horse Show Hitch - On the rail
- D21 Harnessing Race -- timed event - horse led into ring with only a halter & lead on, harness carried in, horse is harnessed and driven out
- D22 Heavy Draft Unicorn Hitch - On the rail
- D23 Light Draft Team Driving – On the rail
- D24 Heavy Draft Junior Team Ages 12-18
- D25 Feed Team Race – timed event – team must manuever through the course picking up and dropping off the “feed”. Penalties for missing the drop area, leaving without the swamper, breaking into a canter, etc.
- D26 Team Log Skid-Timed event- team must manuever through the course- Penalties will apply.
- D27 Heavy Draft Barrel Race

DETAILS YOU NEED TO KNOW.....

Times:

*Gate opens at 6:00 AM. Please be there no later than 6:30 AM to get parked. Parking for big rigs is reserved around the perimeter of the parking lot. Pick up show packets starting at 7:00 AM in the Budweiser Event Center. Look for the sign that says “DRAFT HORSE CHECK-IN”.

*Halter Classes for Draft Horses will begin at 8:30AM

* Performance Classes will begin by 11:30AM

Parking this Year:

We will be parking in Lot E again. Big Rigs, I it is important for you to be there as early as possible so you can maneuver in the space that is reserved for you. The perimeter of Lot E is reserved for the horse vans and multiple hitch rigs, other Draft entries should park in the middle rows of the parking lot. Work with our parking attendant!

Logistics:

*There are no stalls available on the grounds.

*We do not have any wash racks for our use.

*A water wagon will be in the parking lot. You will be able to get water for your horses there.

Day of Class Entries, Cancellations, or Substitutions:

* Late entries will be **\$15.00** per performance class. Please register as early as possible!

If you wish to scratch a class, substitute a driver or horse, please do so as soon as possible Once the class sheets have been handed to the announcer, no changes will be allowed.

*We expect to follow the schedule in this packet. However, if a class has no entries we will cancel it.

Halter Classes:

As you come in to the staging area there may be vehicle traffic coming out of the main gate. Please be cautious and use the south half of the entry gate. This will occur until about 10:00 AM.

Exhibitor Numbers:

When you pick up your entry packet, you will find your exhibitor numbers enclosed. On the back of the exhibitor number will be a label telling you what class that exhibitor number is for. (Some of you will have more than one exhibitor number). Please be sure you use the correct number for your class and display it in a way that the judge and ring steward can easily see it.

Class Times:

You are responsible to be at the gate prior to the start of your class. We reserve the right to close the class for late arrivals to the class. We will use a portable Public Address system to notify you of the classes coming up. Please be ready!!

Class Cancellations/Pull Ups:

If we find we are ahead/behind of schedule, you will be kept informed by the “Rover” who will be driving through the parking lot to keep you informed of class status. We will give you as much notice as possible.

Parking Lot Safety:

There will be a lot of horse and people traffic in the parking lot, the pathway to the arena, and the staging area. Please be cautious as you move your horses between classes. Multiple hitches should use walkers to and from the arena to alert others to your progress.
