

# 2009 Larimer County Fair & Rodeo

## Parade Entry Information

- Times

Parade starts Wednesday, July 29 at 6:30 p.m. Please arrive to line-up by 4:30 p.m. on Parade day. You will obtain your line-up # at the Entry/Registration Table. (see below for locations)

- Staging Areas

The parade will have a staging area on S.E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and south on Railroad Ave. in downtown Loveland.

Horse and other equestrian entries will stage in the HP parking lot just west of the railroad tracks. This used to be used as a parking lot during the rodeo at the old fairgrounds.

Antique cars and tractors will stage in the fire training area (look for the old house).

All floats will line up at either the North field of the Teledyne lot on Railroad Ave. or on Barboura. All walkers will park in the Barnes Ball field lots and walk to the parking lot north of the river on Railroad Ave. **(NO walkers will be allowed on the route until north of the river bridge.)**

Walking groups will mix into the parade at the river bridge or join up with their floats.

- Parking

Barnes Ball Field lots, Fairgrounds Park and at the new dog park. Please park your car and walk to your designated area. There is also additional parking at Blue Ribbon Towing parking lot.

- Railroad Ave. will be closed in both directions from S.E. 3<sup>rd</sup> and Hwy. 402 at 5:00 p.m. day of the parade. **ONLY!!!** parade entries will be allowed to enter from Hwy. 402.

- Entry Tables

Tables will be set up at the corner of Railroad Ave. and Barboura and one will be set up on Railroad Ave. at the river bridge for walking groups only.

- Antique Vehicles

All antique vehicles will be judged on the parade route.

- Floats

Once you have your float complete, please move it onto Railroad Ave. Don't forget to stop and pick up your number at the registration table. Line up on the west side of the street south of the railroad tracks. We will move you up at parade time. **All Floats will be in one line.**

- Walkers

No walkers will be allowed with the floats until the river bridge because of safety risks and the added distance to the route which is almost 1 mile.
